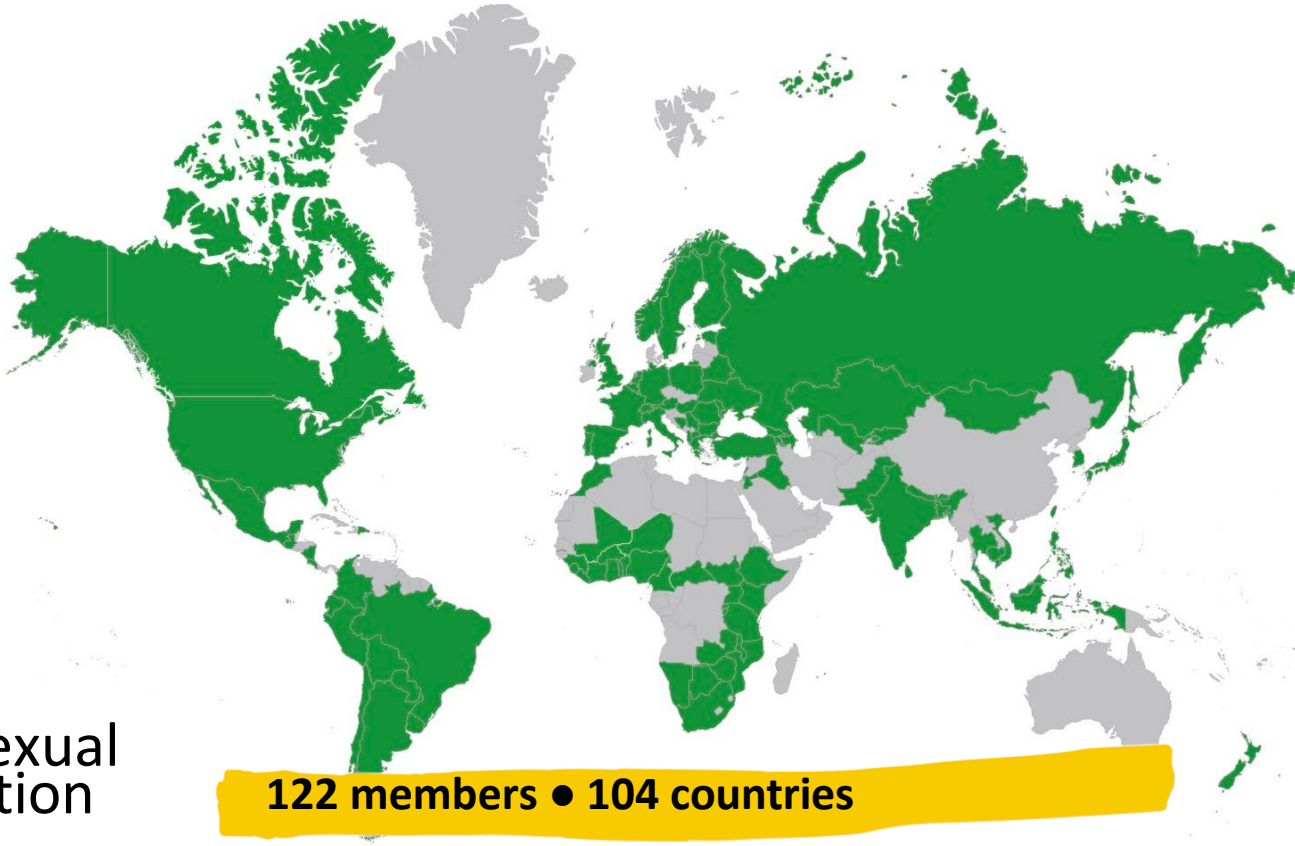

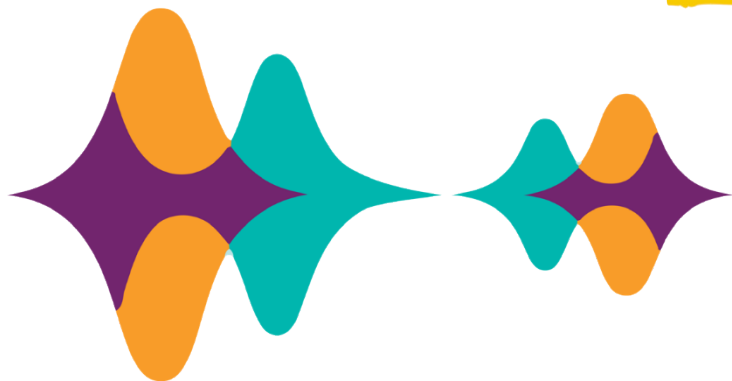


Proposal (2022) for a Regulation laying down rules to prevent and combat sexual abuse of children

Sexualised violence in the digital space - a global problem



Similar results in 13 different countries:



DISRUPTING HARM

- Up to **20% of children** are affected;
- Perpetrators are usually acquaintances or relatives of the child;
- **Children are affected online & offline.**
 - Online mainly via social media

About 1 in 3 children did not tell anyone about the experience. If then

- ...mostly other children/young people
- ...only very rarely to the police, counselling centres or social workers.
