



SEXUAL VIOLENCE THROUGH THE USE OF DIGITAL MEDIA

Cybergrooming	 Perpetrators contact young people online with the abusing them. Places: Social media and also chats of online games.
Abuse via Livestreaming	 Sexual abuse in real time via webcam.

DEPICTIONS OF ABUSE...

... are depictions of sexual violence against children and adolescents in various forms. They show, among other things, explicit acts, sexualised poses or voyeuristic scenes that have been secretly recorded. In addition to photos and videos, these also include computergenerated, painted or acoustic files. In the legal context of Germany, the terms child or youth pornography are used.

A female pupil (16) sends a male pupil (13) a nude picture of herself with the text "Then you can see if you're really gay?!"





On a school trip, a teacher overhears a pupil (16) saying that her uncle has set up an OnlyFans channel for her in order to "push" her career as a model, where he also posts erotic and nude pictures of her.





During a class trip to the mountains, the pupils are supposed to abseil down a rock face. When one female pupil doesn't dare, the teacher gives her an encouraging slap on the bottom.





Marie (13) is being tutored by the French teacher. One day he invites her to the café, on another they have sex. He puts pressure on her and finally films Marie with sex toys.




§ 4 Abs. 10 SchulG SH **EDUCATIONAL AND TRAINING OBJECTIVES**

(10) In order to protect the mental and physical integrity of the pupils, the school shall have a prevention and intervention concept, in particular for threats in connection with sexualised, psychological and physical violence, for the general strengthening and support of the pupils' personality development as well as for structural measures to deal with imminent and existing threats to the welfare of the child.

ROLE OF THE TEACHER

- Knowledge transfer
- Attitude
- Person of trust
- Uncertainty in the subject
- No reliable intervention structures
- Part of identity is potential threat
- Lack of leadership support
- Hardly any team connection





WHAT CAN SCHOOL DO?

- Communicate the right to sexual self-determination in an age-appropriate way.
- Provide space for age-appropriate communication about sexuality, violation of boundaries and violence.
- Awareness of and respect for one's own and others' boundaries, encouraging reflection on one's own behaviour.
- Knowledge about sexualised violence and rules/valid law
- Identify and develop support systems for victims and perpetrators, create or publicise contact points in the institution.
- Communicating the principle "Getting help is not a betrayal!
- Encouraging civil courage
- Developing a safeguarding policy
- Establish regular, age-appropriate prevention programmes.
- Further training for persons working in schools







SEXUAL VIOLENCE THROUGH THE USE OF DIGITAL MEDIA

- Make digital media a topic
- Mention the right to help regularly
- take the importance of the "digital world"
- first ask and react
- Do not punish and condemn
- Do not trivialize
- No victim blaming
